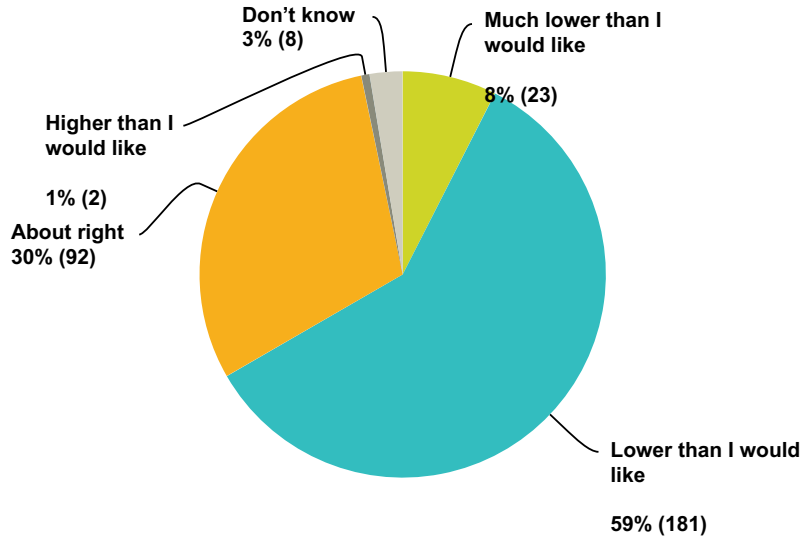


**Q92 On the whole, I would say that my current level of engagement to impact the world as an expression of my Christian discipleship is**

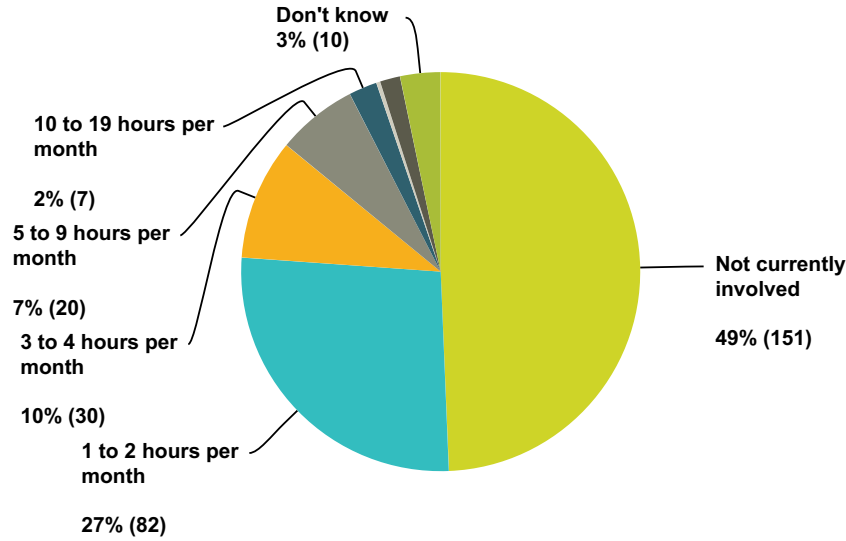

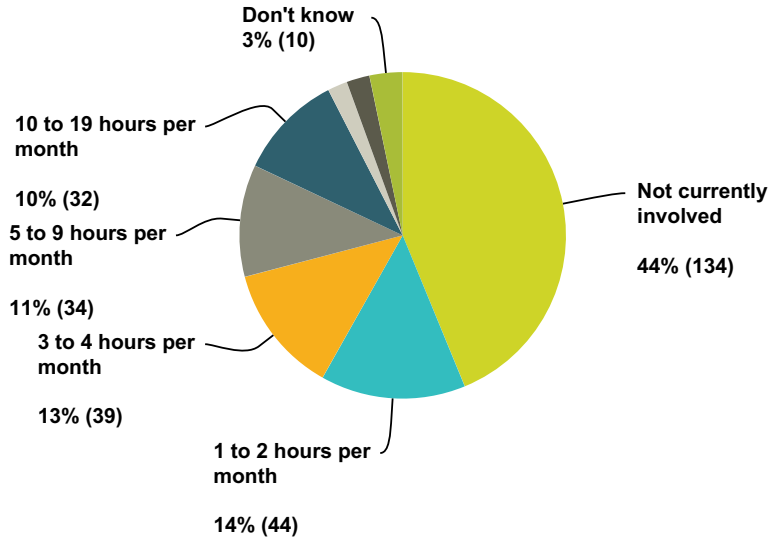

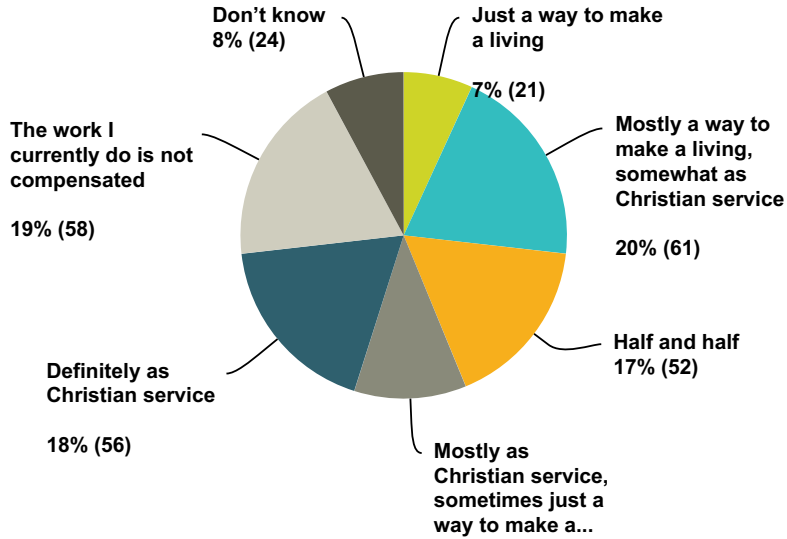

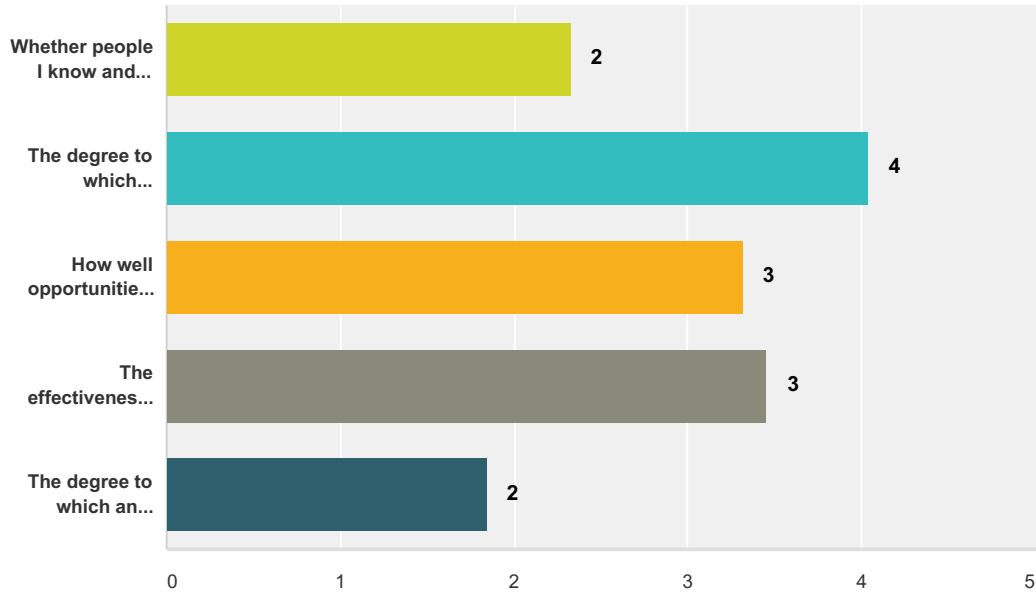

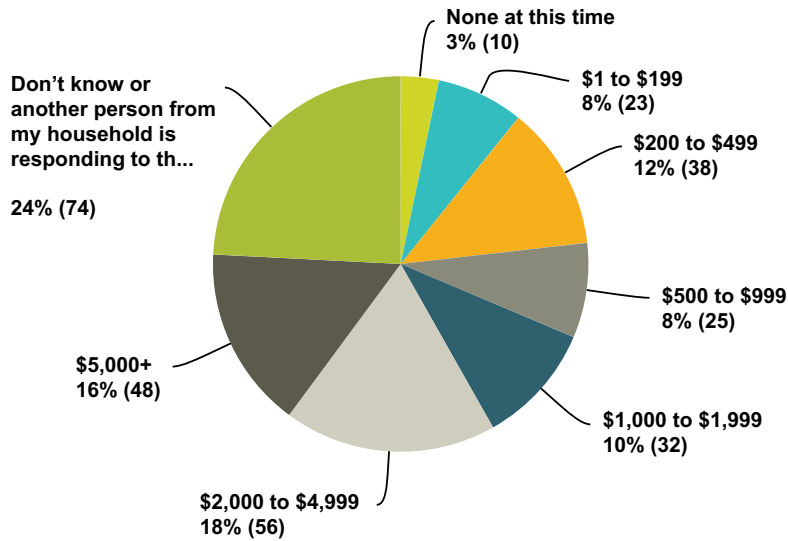

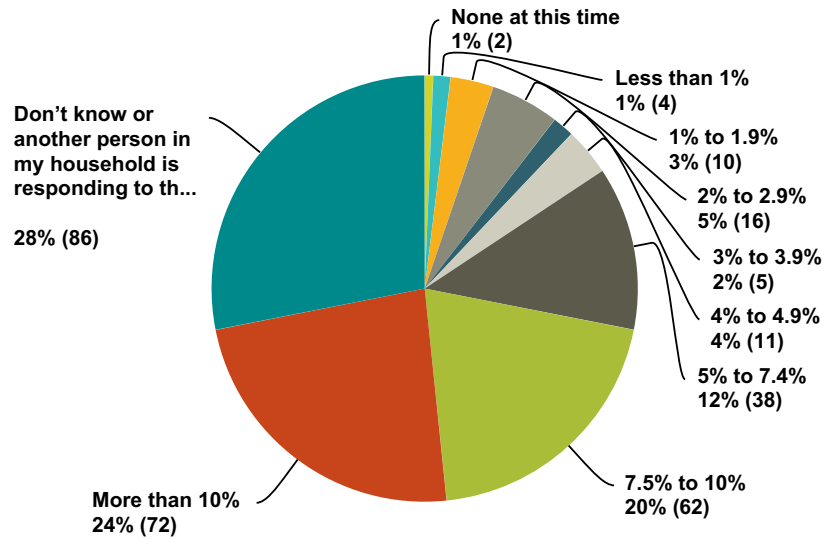
