- a. Looking back on Feasts and what they commemorate helps to build our faith
- b. Understanding the Feasts from a harvest standpoint makes us aware of the great commission (II Pet.3:9; Luke 10:2)
- c. Understanding the prophetic significance of the feasts helps us to know where we are in time (Col.2:16-17)
 - (1) Affects our behavior (II Pet. 3:11-18; Col 3:4-5)
 - (2) Helps us to live each day to the fullest being watchful (Mark 13:37; II Tim 4:8)
 - (3) Gives us eternal perspective (II Cor. 4:17)
 - (4) Shows us futility of getting caught up in earthly pursuits (Heb. 11:13; James 4:14; I Tim 6:7)
 - (5) Helps us to focus, persevere (I Pet. 1:13; Heb.12:1-2)
 - (6) Helps you to know what to do (I chron. 12:32; *Luke 21:28)
