ABOUT THE ABBEY

The Trappist monks have lived, prayed and worked at the Abbey of Gethsemani for over 150 years. The Trappists are a branch of Cistercian monks who follow the Rule of St. Benedict. They are a Roman Catholic order and are known for their contemplative approach.

The community of monks still participate in the "Liturgy of the Hours." Seven times a day the bells ring and the community gathers for prayer on behalf of the entire church and all humankind.

Good things to know: the monastery is considered to be a school of the Lord's service, a training ground of love. Thomas Merton, a pretty famous monk, lived and died here at the abbey. And this abbey is known in particular for it's chocolate and cheese. Yum!
